- Sophomores! If you have completed your on-line application to MVCTC, there will be a meeting today during Quiet Study Hall regarding your possible schedule for next year. The meeting will be held in the Media Center. Check with your homeroom teacher before attending the meeting.
- Sophomores and Juniors! If you took the PSAT in October you may now review your test results on-line! Check the e-mail with which you registered to find your score report and check your AP Potential in preparation for scheduling next year. [psat.org/myscore](http://psat.org/myscore)
- High School Students! Are you taking responsibility for your grades and credits earned in your classes? Your Grade Point Average determines your eligibility for Honor Roll, Principal's List, Admission to MVCTC, Sport Eligibility, Good Student Driving Discounts, National Honor Society, Academic Honors Diploma, College Admission, College Scholarships, Extra-curricular programs, and in some instances...Standard Diploma Requirements. - Will you be a Bethel Local Schools student in grades 7-12 next year? If so, you are potentially eligible to take college classes while you are in Middle School or High School.
